### BUTCHERS BLOCK GSM

GRENACHE · SHIRAZ · MATARO

Named in honour of our family's original use for the building that now houses our Cellar Door, the Butchers Block Red is a structured, fruit-driven & medium bodied wine. A crowd-pleasing style of wine that offers excellent value for money.

#### VINTAGE 2024

The 2024 vintage commenced in February, exactly twenty days earlier than in 2023. Ripening came on quick late January, thanks to lower yields, warmer late season conditions, and lack of rainfall. February recorded 0mm of rain, coupled with a three-week stint of temperatures 30 degrees or above. This created a compressed vintage which was completed in a record five weeks. Despite the conditions, the lower yields produced high quality fruit of intense concentration, ripe tannins, and generous flavour.

#### TASTING NOTES

The higher Grenache component of the 24 blend gives rise to a wine bursting full of energetic summer berries, alongside more subtle notes of dried herb, floral spice and Turkish delight. The palate is juicy and vibrant, with plush plum and dark chocolate notes from the Shiraz, all leading into a long savoury finish. Being more medium bodied, it's a very approachable style for anyone to enjoy.

#### WINEMAKING

In warmer years, picking decisions become even more critical to ensure fruit is picked at optimum ripeness to help retain freshness. Each varietal is then vinified and aged individually in French oak for twelve months before the final blending process. The Grenache adds red fruit and spice on the nose, the Shiraz offers plush fruit and mid-palate weight, and the Mataro adds depth with leather notes and a savoury finish.
